### **The Milford Bank to host Electronics Recovery and Shred Services**

**Milford, CT, March 21, 2012** – The Milford Bank will host an Electronics Disposal Service and a Shred Service on Saturday, May 12<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. The event will be held in the parking lot of the Bank’s Main Office, located at 33 Broad Street on the Milford Green.

During the event, two trucks will be on hand. One will accept unwanted electronics such as appliances, navigational devices, and outdated computer equipment. eReclaim, Inc. of West Haven will responsibly dispose of all collected items.

eReclaim is an electronic waste (e-waste) recovery company that was established for the purpose of eliminating computers and all electronic based products from our landfills. All electronic components are recycled and information left behind in collected electronics is erased within the standards of the Department of Defense five times over.

The other truck will be at the location to dispose of all documents that will be shredded on site. The vendor providing this service is Affordable Solutions of Orange, CT.

These services will be free to customers of The Milford Bank. Non-customers will be asked to make a small contribution to the Connecticut Audubon Society Coastal Center at Milford Point in exchange for the services.
